In addition, individuals or companies can donate unrestricted, tax deductible, funds to the Foundation, or they can specify that the monies are to be used for one of the Foundation's more than 30 different projects, such as: Center Stage, ECHO, Easter Seals Cabin renovation, potable water in other countries, etc."
